

Use Search and Filter for Lesson Planning

Search with keywords

- Select the search tool from the top right corner of the screen.

- Enter a keyword that relates to the content you would like to teach your students, e.g., shape.
- Filter the results using the options at left of screen. For example:
 - Select *Standards*, then
 - Select the curriculum.
 - Select the year or stage, as applicable.
 - Select the strand.
 - Select the outcome (content descriptor).
 - In the *Sort by* dropdown menu, select *Code: A-Z* to access a sequential list of learning experiences within a topic.

Search with the filter

- The search tool can be used without entering a keyword. If you are backwards-mapping from curriculum resources, use only the filter tool to find the most relevant resources.

Search for multi-level resources

- If you are looking for multi-level resources, do not select a year level from the filter. Instead, refer to the year-level tags at the bottom of each learning experience icon in the search results. Please note: the year level may change to match the curriculum or syllabus you select, so make sure you select the most relevant option from the filter.
