

PRODUCT LICENCE STATEMENT

1 Licence Grant

You do not receive title to the Product. Copyright of the Product (which includes all images and text incorporated in the Product, and including all the accompanying printed materials) is owned by the Licensor and/or its suppliers and is protected by Australian copyright laws. The Licensor grants you a non-exclusive licence to use the Product subject to the restrictions and terms set out in this Agreement.

2 Multi-User Licence

As a Purchaser of this Product, you may:

- (i) install the Product on the server in your school/institution and use it simultaneously on multiple computers within your school/institution networked to that server;
- (ii) use the Product on multiple computers within your school/institution by inserting the CD-ROM into the computer's CD-ROM drive;
