1. Math Scores on the Rise Nichols Sawmill Elementary at 100% on STAAR

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When you walk down the halls of Nichols Sawmill Elementary School, you hear the excited chatter of students going to lunch or the playground, and you also hear something unusual: you hear kids talking about math.
